



## >>> OUR FOUNDER

#### Saint John Baptist Scalabrini

was born in Fino Mornasco. Italy on July 8, 1839. He was appointed Bishop of Piacenza, Italy in 1876. Touched by what he saw at the train station of Milan and by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, on November 28, 1887, he founded the Missionaries of St. Charles for migrants. Bishop Scalabrini was beatified on November 9, 1997 by Saint John Paul II. On October 9, 2022, he was canonized by Pope Francis. He is called "Apostle of the Catechism" and "Father to the Migrants."
